There is no evidence that indicates any trace of rape, and the file cannot proceed due to lack of evidence. Moreover, Deniz has a history of using antipsychotic drugs. She appears to be a delusional woman, while Mehmet Emir seems completely flawless. But with a deep sense of justice Deniz is determined to get public exposure for her case and prove that she is right: Mehmet Emir drugged and assaulted her.

However, lying is a habit that has spread like a virus throughout all of society. Even Deniz's idol, her big sister Yasemin, is cheating on her husband with Deniz's ex. She lies not only to her husband, but also to her sister. Mehmet Emir's relationship with his mother is also a big lie. Görkem lies to her husband so that he won't find out that she's been the victim of sexual abuse, and to avoid her marriage falling apart. Canan, Yavuz, Tuğba... Almost everyone around Deniz lives through lies. And as she struggles to tell her truth, Deniz faces an uncomfortable reality - she too must learn to be a liar to get the justice she craves.
