Summary

A successful businessman, Kerem is the heir to a prestigious wine-making family. He is an ideal man: kind, polite, handsome and well-educated.

Everything is orderly and organized in the mansion where he lives with his family. His aunt Nüzhet is the head of the family, and controls everyone and everything in the mansion. She wants Kerem to marry Rana, a family friend who she deems a suitable bride for him. Rana has always been in love with Kerem since they grew up together, but he has only ever seen her as a friend.

Then one summer, unbeknownst to Rana, Kerem finds the love of his life...

Sevda is a law student. She is a free-spirited, energetic, and passionate young woman. Throughout her life, Sevda and her mother have supported each other and overcome all their difficulties together. When an opportunity arises to travel as part of an Erasmus exchange programme, Sevda jumps at the chance to visit Montenegro. While there, she visits a vineyard, where she crosses paths with the handsome wine dealer Kerem.

There is an immediate spark and romantic chemistry between the two, and after a dreamlike day spent together in Montenegro, they agree to meet in the same place exactly a year later.

But fate intervenes, and they are reunited unexpectedly, not in the vineyards of Montenegro, but in Istanbul where Sevda, her mother, and her brother have turned in desperate trouble: Sevda has no idea that Kerem comes from a rich background, so when she accepts a job helping her mother at work as a maid in the home of a prestigious family in Istanbul, she is shocked to discover that she is working for Kerem.

And though Kerem is surprised to see that Sevda comes from such humble origins, his feelings for her are undeniable - though the resulting conflict with his family will be as great as his love.

But this couple will do anything to overcome the problems in their lives and the class differences between them - anything to live their love without limits.







RANA – Sanem Babi

Rana, an Ottoman descendant who lost her parents in France when she was young and was brought to Istanbul and raised by the Sipahiogulları, is characterized by ambition, jealousy, and obsessive love for Kerem. There is another face she hides under her calm and caring appearance: her passion for Kerem, her childhood love, will reveal her dark side.



NÜZHET – Arzu Gamze Kılınç

Nüzhet is the lady of the mansion and the embodiment of authority itself. She is ready to do anything and everything to ensure that the order she has established and administered is not disrupted. Her family comes first. No matter how evil she becomes, she never feels remorse because she has done it for her family and the continuity of this family. As her secrets are revealed in time, she shows her true face.



FEVZIYE – Zeynep Köse

Fevziye is the eldest daughter of Kerem's family. She always obeyed her aunt Nüzhet and put the interests and continuity of the family ahead of her own life. Fevziye, who is calm and devoted to her family, was also influenced by her aunt during her marriage and had an unhappy and childless marriage with Selim. With Sevda's arrival at the mansion, she too will discover her womanhood.





ALTYE – Nazlı Bulum

Aliye is the middle child of the family. She is a cheerful, energetic, sympathetic, and promising young woman in contrast to the gloomy and controlled atmosphere of the house. Her only fear is her aunt Nüzhet. However, even though she is afraid, she has a rebellious spirit like her mother, Süreyya - who she has never met.



PERIHAN – Betül Çobanoğlu

Grapes of Love

Perihan's beauty attracts attention first, then her success in surviving on her own and how she protects her children under all circumstances. Although marrying Naci was her biggest mistake, this marriage gave her two loving children, Sevda and Memo. However, this mistake will haunt her for the rest of her life.

MEMED – Çınar Yükçeker

Memed is the son of Naci and Perihan, and Sevda's naive brother. He is the closest witness to the violence his father inflicts on his mother. He is also affected by this violence. No matter how big and painful his experiences are, he will never lose his little boy's spirit and purity. He is a loving child who must always be protected under his mother's wings.






SULTAN – Fulya Ülvan






BAHRI – Mete Ayhan
