The lonely craftsman Eder sends away his invisible friend Pumuckl so that he can work on his carousel in peace. But the little goblin misunderstands and thinks his friend has ended their friendship.

When a simple repair job for an eccentric opera conductor spirals wildly out of control, the mismatched pair find themselves chasing runaway animals, uncovering rural secrets, and ultimately facing a grand showdown on the stage of the State Opera. Pumuckl rides along invisibly, stirring up trouble at every turn. Eder, the steady hand, tries to keep the peace and fix what's broken. But when Pumuckl begins to fear their friendship won't survive these changes, both must discover what truly matters: where you belong, and who you belong with.

THE AMAZING MAURICE - THE WATERS OF LIFE

Maurice, the most amazing cat in the world, or so he says, along with Malicia, Keith and the Clan Rats, are back for another thrilling adventure in a tale of pirates, vampires, werewolves and sirens, a furless cat and a perilous quest to find the Waters of Life. A Sky Original based on the books by Sir Terry Pratchett.

Maurice fears life is too cosy living with Malicia and Keith. He decides to run away, hoping to find a new life at sea as a ship's cat. Malicia's father, the Mayor, is seriously ill. Malicia learns the only thing that might save him is the Waters of Life. When Malicia finds a map showing the location of the Waters, she and Peaches go on a quest to find them. They stow away on a barge... only to find Maurice aboard. Safely away from port, the barge transforms into 'The Lorelei', a pirate ship run by a power-hungry cat named Admiral Katz. Maurice wants Katz' job... cue the catfight. Meanwhile, Keith travels by horse and carriage with rats Darktan and Dangerous Beans in a bid to catch up with Malicia. Their journey sees them facing vampires, werewolves and sirens. Will Malicia find the Waters of Life and save her father? Will Keith find Malicia but lose his trousers? Will Maurice learn the true value of home? You bet... but not in any way that's expected.

The English-language animated feature is, like the multi-award-winning first film, based on the books by Sir Terry Pratchett and his popular Discworld novels, which have sold over 100 million copies in 37 languages. The first Maurice film grossed a global box office over 24 million US\$ and made the top 5 in almost every territory. The movie won a British Animation Award, a Pulcinella Award, was nominated for the European Film Award and longlisted at the BAFTA Film Awards and the "Oscars" Academy Awards. It premiered in the U.S. at the Sundance Film Festival. The creative team behind "The Amazing Maurice" movie has reunited for this exciting new adventure which is to be directed by Toby Genkel ("Ooops! Noah is Gone...", Paul McCartney's "High in the Clouds") and Chris Drew ("The Adventures of Paddington"). The film is produced once again by Emely Christians ("The Niko Trilogy", "Two by Two: Overboard!"), Andrew Baker ("Bad Jelly", "Bollywoof"), and Robert Chandler ("A Christmas Number One", "The Canterville Ghost"). DREAMERS - THE HUNT FOR SHADOWCLAW

CGI | Family Entertainment | Germany, Canada | approx. 85 min | Q4 2028

A wannabe K9 on wheels, a beatboxing duck on the autism spectrum, and a dancing bear with Down syndrome must band together to rescue a runaway circus panther – a thrilling chase through New York led by three extraordinary heroes.

An unlikely trio: Lenny, a young Belgian Malinois, flunked his K9 police dog exam - not because of his wheels, but his stubborn streak. To prove himself worthy he teams up with Fred, a beatboxing Indian Runner duck on the autism spectrum, and Bearnice, a lighthearted female black bear with Down syndrome who lives to sing and dance. They must defy the odds to save a runaway panther in the heart of New York City. Lenny rides the streets like no other, sniffing out clues. Fred, the genius duck with rhythm, cracks the case wide open: Where will the panther go next? And Bearnice, the soul of the team, brings the empathy that just might calm the wild feline. But to truly save Shadowclaw, they'll need more than heart - they'll need to become a perfect team. Together, they must turn their differences into superabilities before the bully K9 pack leader and his unit close in.

DREAMERS celebrates characters who are extraordinarily able - embracing their disabilities. With a stylized visual aesthetic, the film is set to bring a fresh and never before inclusive perspective to animated storytelling. The production is led by Ulrich Schwarz ("Dragon Rider", "Nessie Junior", "Stowaway"), Andreas Schneider's Parapictures Film Production ("Gold"), Thomas Baumgarten ("Klaus"), and Arno Hazebroek's Falcon Features ("500 Miles", "Hope Gap") in co-poduction with Epsilon Film.

The animation is being handled by Kickstart Entertainment, a proven animation and live-action international independent studio with over 25 years of producing over 750 episodes, and 20 feature films. Working in all formats and with trusted brands, including projects such as "Barbie Mysteries" (Netflix/Mattel) and "The Boys" (Amazon).

This family adventure is written by Rob Moreland ("Shrek", "Space Chimps", "Gnome Alone"), Alison James (award-winning children's book author) and Christopher Jenkins ("10 Lives", "Surf's Up"). Heiko Hentschel ("The Amazing Maurice", "Oops! Noah is Gone...", "Luis and the Aliens", "The Elfkins") serves as character designer.

NESSIE JUNIOR

When Finn, a young Loch Ness Monster raised far from his ancestral home, dares to return to the legendary Loch Ness to uncover his family's secrets, he must rely on an unlikely ally - Kellina, a spirited teenage girl whose life was once touched by one of his kind. Together, they dive into a breathtaking world beneath the Scottish Highlands to uncover the truth behind an ancient mystery, mend broken bonds, and prove that courage and friendship can bridge even the deepest divides.

On the surface, Loch Ness has become a bustling tourist destination overlooked by the ruins of the ancient Urquhart Castle. Local showman Mylo - Kellina's father - runs a ramshackle monster-themed attraction, claiming he once encountered the real creature. His sceptical daughter doesn't believe in his tales of monsters or myths... until she meets Finn. What follows is a thrilling, heart-warming adventure filled with humour, danger and wonder, as two worlds collide and a legendary friendship is born.

NESSIE JUNIOR is a visually spectacular, emotionally uplifting CGI-animated family film inspired by the enduring myth of the Loch Ness Monster - one of the world's most recognisable legends. Combining rich Scottish landscapes with high-end animation, it delivers a story of courage, connection and hope for audiences everywhere. The co-screenwriter and director of the Netflix original animated musical fantasy "Scrooge - A Christmas Carol" (nominated for two London Critics' Circle Film Awards) is taking over the direction. The producers' team is Matthias Drescher, known for "Shifting the Blame" and the Emmy-winning "War of Lies", along with Ulrich Schwarz, co-producer of Constantin Film's "Dragon Rider" and producer of the Netflix sci-fi thriller "Stowaway". And Ken Anderson, co-producer of Studio100's "Princess Emmy" and "The Brilliant World of Tom Gates". Character design is by Peter Oedekoven ("Stitch Head", "Amazing Maurice") and Randy Bishop ("Scrooge - A Christmas Carol", "Monster High"). Armed only with her determination and Harold's friendship, Mimi recklessly jumps into paintings to find her beloved owner - and Harold becomes the hero he never dreamt of being.

Mimi is a brave, scruffy dog belonging to Evi, a little girl. One day, playing in a wheat field with her owner, Mimi sees the whole world around her falling apart, the fields and Evi vanishing before her fearful eyes. Summoning all her courage, she hurls herself into the white nothingness! In the present day, Harold, another dog, a real one, is with his owner, Lori, in a museum. Harold, who aspires to be an artist, is waiting for inspiration to strike. Mimi, a painted dog, gradually wins over the proud and superior Harold, by showing him - a highbrow lover of art - her ability to leap into paintings. Yakari, the little Sioux, wants to save his injured friend Buffalo-Seed. While Rainbow tries to heal their friend, Yakari gallops with Little Thunder to the far reaches of Sioux territory to seek help from the only being capable of awakening him: Buffalo-Seed's totem, the fearsome giant bison Thathanka!

Yakari, protected by Great Eagle, his totem, who gave him the fabulous power to talk to animals, lives happily in the land of the Sioux. He gallops with his friend, the wild mustang Little Thunder, and plays with two friends his own age, Rainbow and Buffalo-Seed. Yakari proudly wears his feather of bravery, proof of the tribe's respect for him. But such honor makes one jealous: Buffalo-Seed, breaking their oath of friendship, defies authority and puts himself in great danger by attempting to capture a bison on his own.
