DREAMERS - THE HUNT FOR SHADOWCLAW

CGI | Family Entertainment | Germany, Canada | approx. 85 min | 2028

A wannabe K9 dog on wheels, a beatboxing duck on the autism spectrum, and a dancing bear with Down syndrome must defy the odds to rescue a runaway circus panther – a thrilling chase through New York with extraordinary heroes.

An unlikely trio – a young German Shepherd who flunked K9 training, not because of his wheels, but his stubborn streak, a beatboxing Indian Runner duck on the autism spectrum, and a black bear with Down syndrome who lives to dance for the circus crowd – must defy the odds to save a runaway panther in the heart of New York City. Lenny rides the streets like no other, sniffing out clues on wheels. Fred, the genius with rhythm, cracks the case wide open: Where will the panther go next? And Bearnice, the soul of the team, brings the empathy that just might calm the wild feline. But to truly save Shadowclaw, they'll need more than heart – they'll need to become a perfect team. Together, they must turn their differences into superpowers before the official K9 unit closes in.

DREAMERS is a 3D-CGI animated feature that celebrates characters who are extraordinarily able – despite their disabilities. With a stylized visual aesthetic, the film is set to bring a fresh and inclusive perspective to animated storytelling. The production is led by Ulrich Schwarz ("Dragon Rider", "Nessie Junior", "Stowaway"), Andreas Schneider's Parapictures Film Production ("Gold"), Thomas Baumgarten ("Klaus"), and Arno Hazebroek's Falcon Features ("500 Miles", "Hope Gap").

The animation for DREAMERS is being handled by Kickstart Entertainment, a proven animation and live-action international independent studio with over 25 years of producing over 750 episodes, and 20 feature films. Working in all formats and with trusted brands, including projects such as "Barbie Mysteries" (Netflix/Mattel) and "The Boys" (Amazon).

This family adventure is written by Rob Moreland ("Shrek", "Gnome Alone") and Alison James (award-winning children's book author) and Heiko Hentschel ("The Amazing Maurice, "Ooops! Noah is Gone...", "The Elfkins", "Luis and the Aliens") serves as character designer. EPSILON FILM co-produces and handles international sales, bringing this exciting and meaningful project to a global audience.

THE AMAZING MAURICE - THE WATERS OF LIFE

CGI | Family Entertainment | UK, Germany | 90 min | 2027

Maurice, the most amazing cat in the world, or so he says, along with Malicia, Keith and the Clan Rats, are back for another thrilling adventure in a tale of pirates, vampires, werewolves and sirens, a furless cat and a perilous quest to find the Waters of Life. A Sky Original based on the books by Sir Terry Pratchett.

Maurice, living with Malicia and Keith in Bad Blintz, is afraid that he is being domesticated. He steals away, hopping onto a barge, hoping to find a new life at sea as a ship's cat, something he's always wanted. Malicia's father, the Mayor, is seriously ill. Malicia learns the only thing that might save him is the Waters of Life, which her aunts, the Grim Sisters, wrote about in their 'Grim Book of Fairy Stories'. Malicia and Peaches head to the docks and stow away on a barge sailing up the river... only to find Maurice aboard. The barge is attacked by 'The Lorelei', a pirate ship captained by a furless cat, Admiral Katz. Maurice wants Katz's job. Katz surprises Maurice by telling him he can't have it - Katz can talk, too! Maurice doesn't like that. Cue the catfight. Keith, who should have accompanied Malicia on her quest, travels with the Clan Rats in a bid to catch up with Malicia. Their journey sees them facing vampires in recovery therapy and a werewolf who is a balding literary scholar by day in the forests of Uberwald. Will our heroes meet eventually? Will Malicia find the Waters of Life? Will Keith lose his trousers? You bet... but not in any way that's expected.

The English-language animated feature is, like the multi-award-winning first film, based on the books by Sir Terry Pratchett and his popular Discworld novels, which have sold over 100 million copies in 37 languages. The first Maurice film grossed a global box office over 24 million US\$ and made the top 5 in almost every territory. The movie won a British Animation Award, a Pulcinella Award, was nominated for the European Film Award and longlisted at the BAFTA Film Awards and the "Oscars" Academy Awards. It premiered in the U.S. at the Sundance Film Festival.

The creative team behind "The Amazing Maurice" movie has reunited for this exciting new adventure which is to be directed again by Toby Genkel ("Ooops! Noah is Gone...", "Paul McCartney's High in the Clouds"). The film is produced once again by Emely Christians ("Niko & The Way to the Stars", "Two by Two: Overboard!"), Andrew Baker ("Bad Jelly", "Bollywoof"), and Robert Chandler ("A Christmas Number One", "The Canterville Ghost"). Character design is by Carter Goodrich ("Finding Nemo", "Shrek") and Heiko Hentschel ("Ooops! Noah is Gone..."), with the script written by Giles New and Keiron Self ("The Canterville Ghost", "Mimi & Harold - Out of Frame").

NESSIE JUNIOR

CGI | Family Entertainment | Germany, UK | 90 min | 2028

Fin, aka Nessie Junior, facing a family challenge, embarks on a dangerous journey to his ancestral home, the mystical Loch Ness. Once there, he has to rely on the help of an unexpected human friend, Kellina, to unravel a gigantic mystery and save the last of his kind.

The beautiful lake of Loch Ness, overlooked by the ruins of Urquhart Castle, has become a highly attractive holiday destination. Local fisherman, Mylo, who claims to have been attacked by the sea creature, runs a Loch Ness Monster tourist show on the banks of the loch. His teenage daughter, Kellina, doesn't believe his stories, nor does she believe in any of the myths of Loch Ness ... but that all changes when she meets an actual young Nessie called Finn. And so begins a tale of friendship and caution, loyalty and betrayal, fun and breathtaking adventure as the pair team up to uncover the sea creature's family secrets hidden in the water's depths.

NESSIE JUNIOR is an exciting, unique, and entertaining high-end CGI-animated movie based on the tale of the Loch Ness Monster, the mythical creature that has for centuries attracted travellers and sightseers to the Scottish Highlands.

The co-screenwriter and director of the Netflix original animated musical fantasy "Scrooge - A Christmas Carol" (nominated for two London Critics' Circle Film Awards) is taking over the direction. The producers' team is Matthias Drescher, known for "Shifting the Blame" and the Emmy-winning "War of Lies," along with Ulrich Schwarz, co-producer of Constantin Film's "Dragon Rider" and producer of the Netflix sci-fi thriller "Stowaway". The multi-award winning producer and entrepreneur Ken Anderson, one of the foremost Children's and Animation Producers in the UK, responsible for hit series like "The Brilliant World of Tom Gates", "64 Zoo Lane", "Pablo the Little Red Fox", "Ask Lara", "Wendy", "The Imp" and "Dennis & Gnasher" serves as producer.

Armed only with her determination and Harold's friendship, Mimi recklessly jumps into paintings to find her beloved owner - and Harold becomes the hero he never dreamt of being.

Mimi is a brave, scruffy dog belonging to Evi, a little girl. One day, playing in a wheat field with her owner, Mimi sees the whole world around her falling apart, the fields and Evi vanishing before her fearful eyes. Summoning all her courage, she hurls herself into the white nothingness! In the present day, Harold, another dog, a real one, is with his owner, Lori, in a gallery. Harold, who aspires to be an artist, is waiting for inspiration to strike. Mimi, a painted dog, gradually wins over the proud and superior Harold, by showing him - a highbrow lover of art - her ability to leap into paintings. Yakari, the little Sioux, wants to save his injured friend Buffalo-Seed. While Rainbow tries to heal their friend, Yakari gallops with Little Thunder to the far reaches of Sioux territory to seek help from the only being capable of awakening him: Buffalo-Seed's totem, the fearsome giant bison Thathanka!

Yakari, protected by Great Eagle, his totem, who gave him the fabulous power to talk to animals, lives happily in the land of the Sioux. He gallops with his friend, the wild mustang Little Thunder, and plays with two friends his own age, Rainbow and Buffalo-Seed. Yakari proudly wears his feather of bravery, proof of the tribe's respect for him. But such honor makes one jealous: Buffalo-Seed, breaking their oath of friendship, defies authority and puts himself in great danger by attempting to capture a bison on his own. 

EPSILON FILM is a joint venture between Alice von Einem (née Buquoy) and Julia Weber, two former Global Screen executives, and the Beta Group. The newly founded world sales company focuses on brand-based content, original movies, family entertainment, and highend action. They scout for and engage in projects at the earliest stages, maintaining a close, hands-on approach throughout development, financing, and production to acquire and produce high-quality, commercially appealing feature films. Epsilon's vision is to create synergies through Beta's outstanding TV sales division, production companies, distribution entities, and service providers, among others.

At its first three markets since its founding — the Marché du Film in Cannes and AFM in Las Vegas in 2024, followed by the EFM in Berlin in 2025 — EPSILON FILM made a strong debut with a high-quality lineup of animated features.
