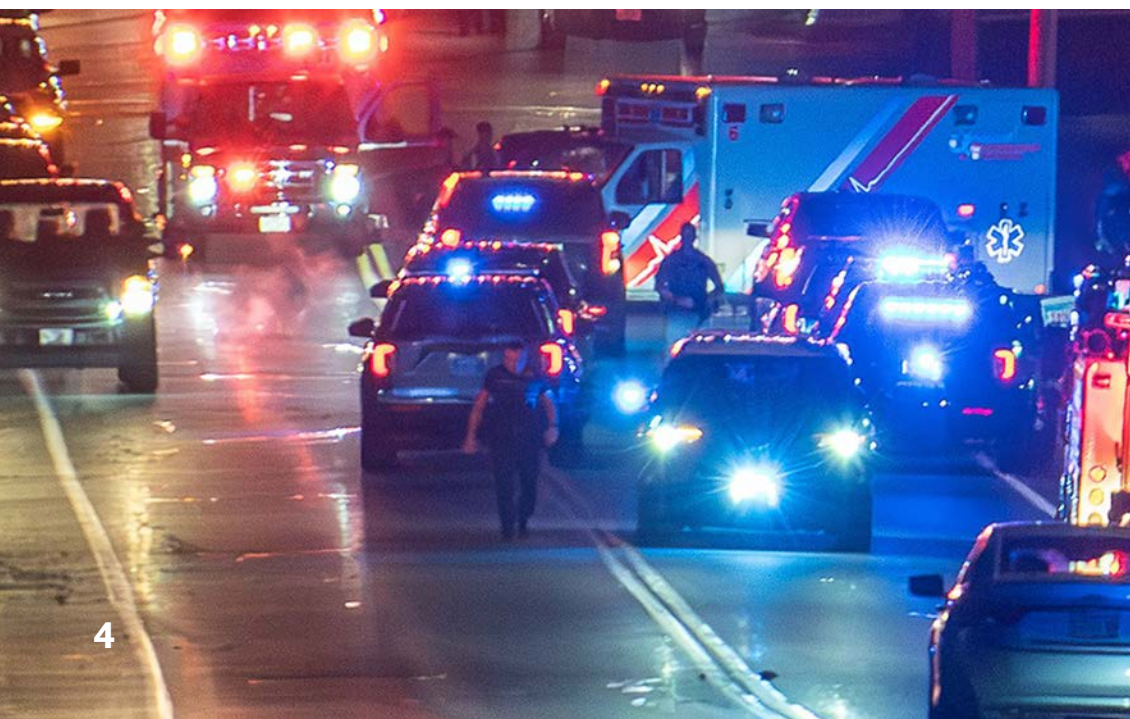

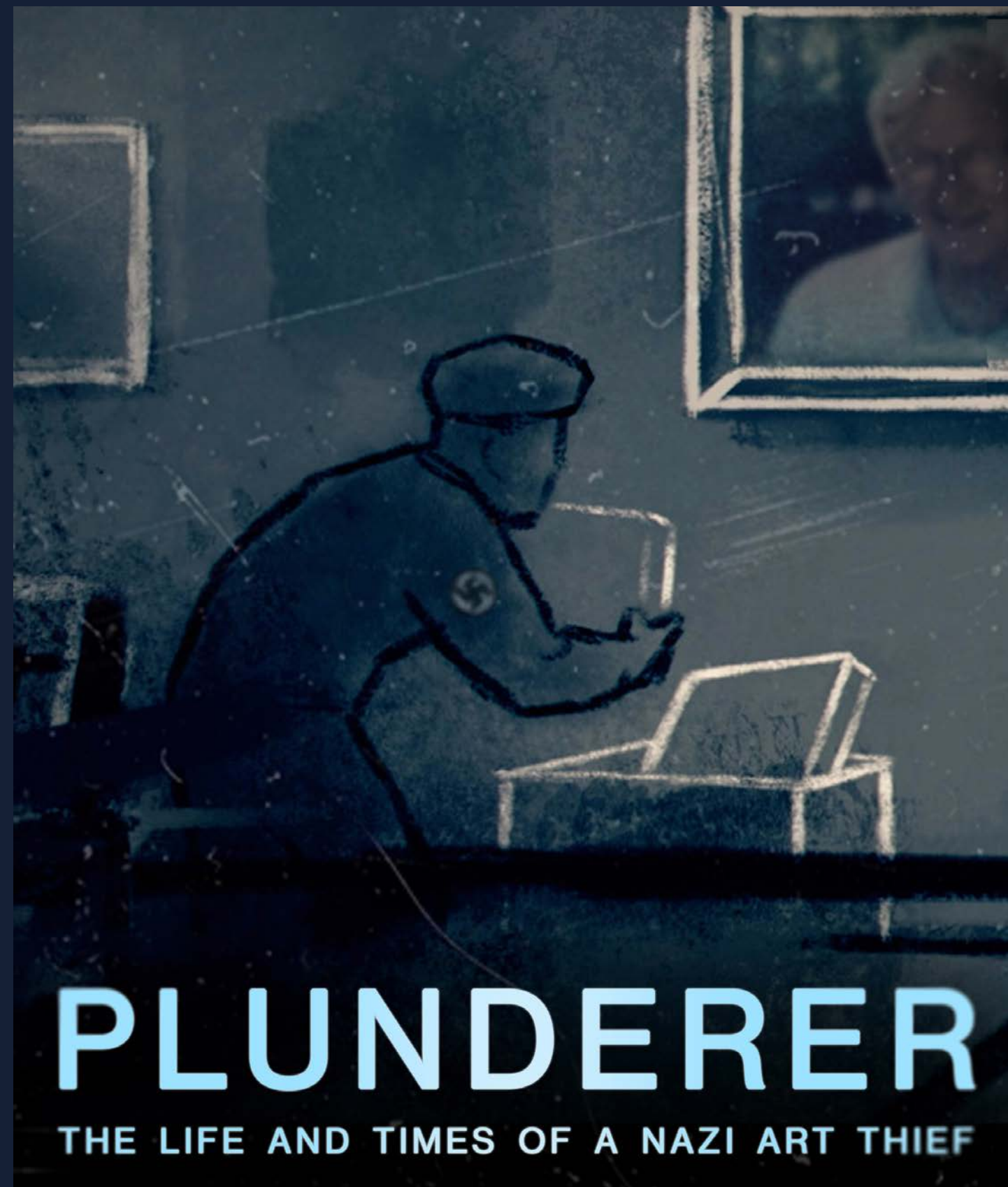

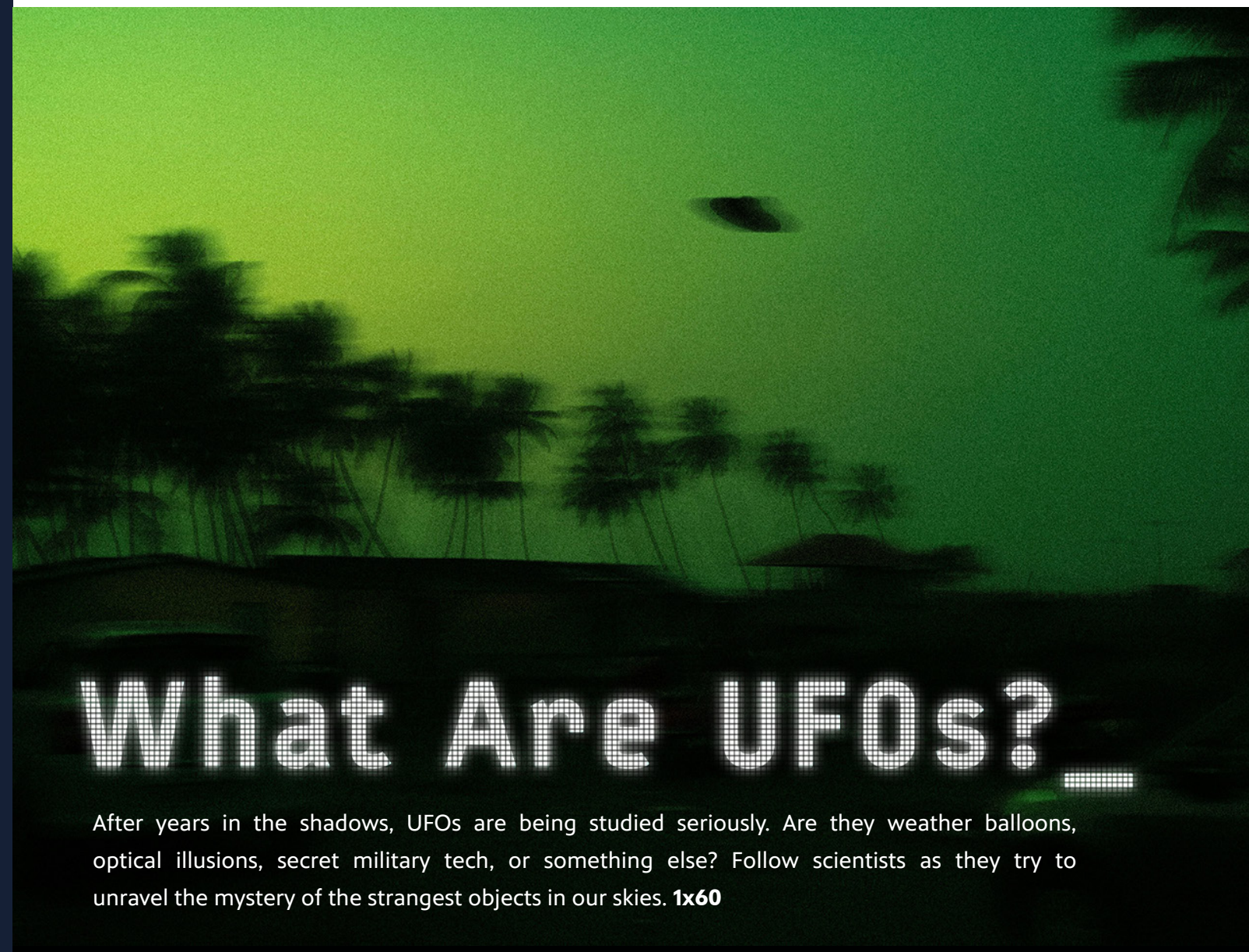
FORGOTTEN HERO WALTER WHITE AND THE NAACP

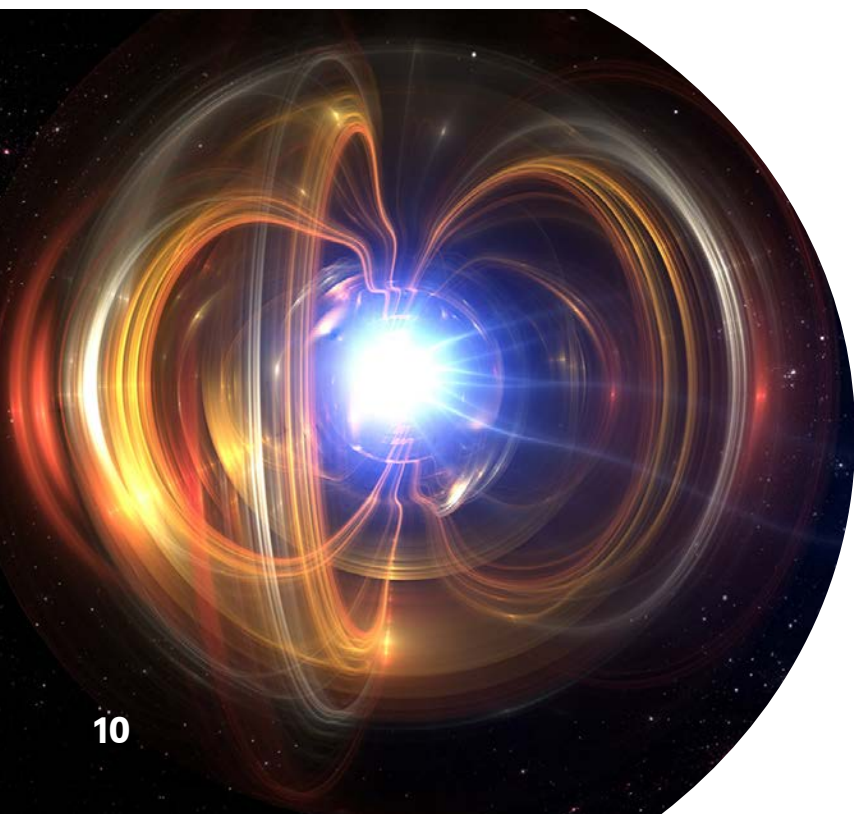

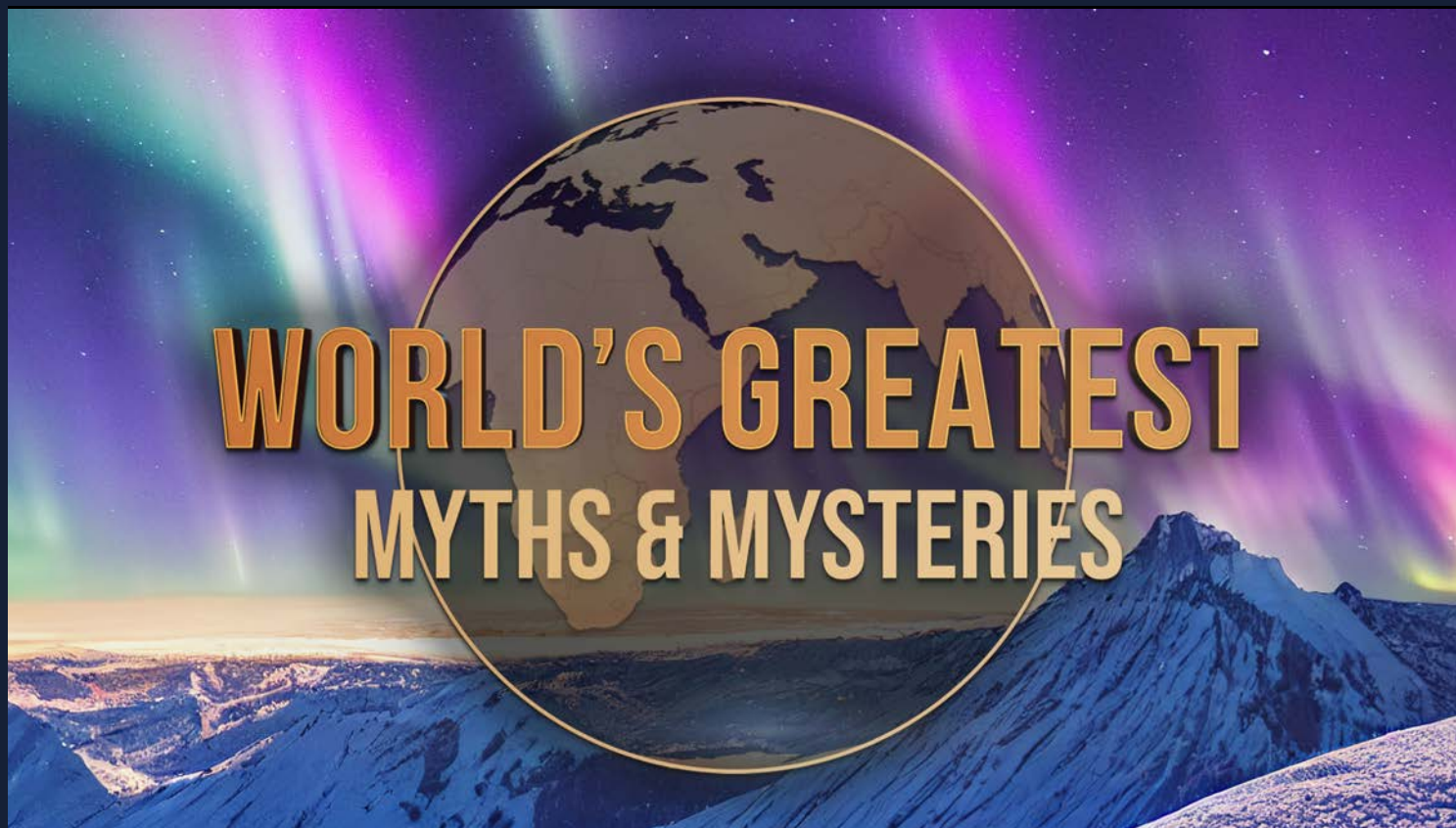
